#### **Directions**

**South on the 405 Fwy:** Take Exit 37 Vermont Ave. Turn right at the end of the offramp onto 190th St. Continue West on 190th St. past the light at Normandie Ave. and turn right into the 1st driveway past Normandie into Mazak's parking lot.

**North on 405 Fwy:** Just past the 110 Fwy., take Exit 38A for Normandie Ave. Use any lane to turn left onto Normandie Ave. Turn right on W. 190th St. Turn into Mazak's parking lot (1st driveway on right).

**South on the 110 Fwy:** Just past the 91 Fwy., take the 190 St. Exit. Turn right onto 190th St. and progress to the 1st driveway on your right past the traffic light at Normandie Ave.

**North on the 110 Fwy:** Exit to the 405 Fwy North toward Santa Monica. Take Exit 38A for Normandie Ave. Use any lane to turn left onto Normandie Ave. Turn right onto 190th then right into the 1st driveway.
