From Space Science to the Emerging Space Economy: A Personal Journey

This presentation will present a personal journey from a career dedicated to robotic space exploration and space science at NASA's JPL, into the exciting world of space entrepreneurship.

Without any doubt, we are in the early stages of a lasting revolution in space commercialization and democratization. Whereas Lower Earth Orbit (LEO) is the immediate and obvious destination for space commercialization, as evidenced by the plethora of applications including: existing and emerging constellations of Earth orbiting satellites for imaging, weather prediction, climate change monitoring, broadband communications; data and compute centers in space; in-space manufacturing; space tourism; in-orbit servicing and assembly; defense, space intelligence and situational awareness; secure global economic transactions, and much more.

There is also plenty of opportunities in the emerging Lunar and cis-Lunar economy including in-situ resource prospecting and

Dr. Leon Alkalai is a retired Fellow of the NASA Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL), California Institute of Technology. He joined JPL in 1989 after receiving his PhD in Computer Science from UCLA. His 32-year career at JPL

included technology development in microavionics, miniaturized spacecraft systems, systems-on-a-chip technologies, small satellites, in-situ robotic planetary missions, mission formulation, strategic planning, and strategic partnerships.

Leon Alkalai was the JPL Capture Lead for the GRAIL mission to the Moon which

launched in 2011 to the Earth's Moon; and the Capture Lead for the INSIGHT mission to Mars, which launched and successfully landed on Mars in 2018. For his contributions to both the GRAIL and the INSIGHT missions, Leon received NASA Distinguished Individual Achievement Medals, as well as Group Achievement Awards for leading the two JPL capture teams to success.

In the last few years before retiring form JPL in early 2021, Leon led the development of the JPL Strategic Implementation Plan https://jpl.nasa.gov/sip and oversaw JPL Strategic Partnerships with a broad range of domestic and international partners.

Since retiring from JPL, Leon founded the Pasadena-based Mandala Space Ventures, LLC incubator focused on launching new businesses in space and commercializing space technologies for the benefit of humanity on Earth. Mandala recently launched Continuum Space Systems, LLC, which is a Software as a Service (SaaS) company offering a software platform for the rapid onboarding of companies entering the space business as well as for existing constellations in LEO. Leon is also a General Partner in the Explorer 1 Venture Fund, a Mandala Space Ventures affiliated venture fund.
