
Who We Are...


• Conduct monthly meetings with presentations, panels and tours with industry leaders focused on some aspect of the business of A&D










Grant Eligibility Requirements

- Grant Amount: fixed-price grants ranging \$500,000-\$1.5 million USD
- Who Can Apply:
 - Grantees are overseas entities (public, private, or parastatal) in lower to middle income countries as classified by the World Bank Group
 - A U.S. firm must conduct the USTDA-funded feasibility study
- What Can We Fund: Grants typically cover labor involved in project preparation activities. USTDA typically only works with commercially deployed technology. USTDA does not fund equipment.
- U.S. Exports: USTDA is generally seeking to support larger infrastructure activities that could potentially lead to upwards of \$10 million USD in U.S. exports
